

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### "EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

In order to compete at a USEF licensed competition with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated above in GR901.9 items 1-11) each horse must be registered with the USHJA.

#### FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing the entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

- 1. Unless otherwise noted all classes are run in accordance with USEF rules and regulations.
- 2. The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries accepted in any division/class (USEF Rule GR915). Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis based on date and time stamp until the number desired is reached in each division or class. The Committee may vary the number accepted in each division/class in order to achieve the desired overall figure.

All entries will be initially submitted into a pending status until they are reviewed by management. A non-refundable office processing fee of \$70 will be charged at the time of entry. After review, entries will be accepted in order of receipt and all additional prepaid fees will be charged at that time to the card on file. Entries placed on the wait list for all entered classes will not be charged any additional prepaid fees until they are accepted.

- 3. Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to deny, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to redesign any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes or to reschedule classes (after notice to exhibitors); to change rings or switch judges; to change criteria in hunter, breeding and jumper classes as the show warrants.
- 4. Entry questions and communications will only be received at and answered from uchs.enter@gmail.com.

#### 5. ENTRY CLOSING DATES:

Hunter & Jumper Entries Close MAY 1, 2024 - Entries made after 5/1/24 will be accepted if time and space permits, and will incur a \$50 late fee

Back from Track, Too Slow to Go & Thoroughbred Hunter Development Entries Close JUNE 1, 2024 – Entries made after 6/1/24 will be accepted if time and space permits for a \$50 late fee

Hunter Breeding, Pony Breeding & Connemara Entries Open MAY 2, 2024, Close FRIDAY, JUNE 7, 2024 at Noon.

Sidesaddle Entries Open MAY 2, 2024, Close FRIDAY, JUNE 7, 2024 at Noon.

Lead Line and Walk Trot Entries Open MAY 2, 2024, Close FRIDAY, JUNE 7, 2024 at Noon.

Cleveland Bay Entries Open MAY 2, 2024, Close FRIDAY, JUNE 7, 2024 at Noon.

Irish Hunter Entries Open MAY 2, 2024, Close FRIDAY, JUNE 7, 2024 at Noon.

- 6. Entries must be made through HorseShowsOnline. A current mailing address, telephone numbers and Social Security Number or Federal ID Number for each prize money recipient must be provided.
- 7. All entries must be accompanied by payment of necessary fees and applicable Association Membership Numbers. Checks may be made payable to Upperville Colt & Horse Show (UCHS). Credit card on file will be required for all entries before horse numbers will be given to the exhibitor. 5% processing fee will be assessed for credit card payments at closeout. Exhibitors may close out accounts by check. A fee of \$50 will be assessed for all returned checks and account will be closed with credit card on file including an additional 5% processing fee, plus \$35 close out fee.
- 8. Non-Showing Horses: A \$300 non-showing horse fee will be charged for any horse on grounds that does not compete in one or more classes during the show.
- 9. Substitutions: A \$150 substitution fee will be charged for any horse entered in place of an entry scratched from the show. Substitutions are considered by management on a case by case basis as space permits.
- 10. To simplify your arrival at the show, please check in with: a hard copy of Negative Coggins Certificate (within 12 months of 6/9/24) and current EHV vaccination record within 6 months of 6/9/24. Numbers will not be issued until all of the required information has been presented. Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

- 11. As of Dec. 1, 2017 the USEF will require a microchip for horses and ponies competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration.
- 12. As per USEF GR 845, horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Health Certificates (within 30 days) required for all out of state horses. These documents must be available for inspection by a representative of the State Veterinarian upon request. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.
- 13. Scratches: Office fee not refundable. Stabling fees will be refunded for horses scratched before May 1 closing. Scratch information and questions will be received at and answered from uchs.enter@gmail.com.
- 14. Prize Money: Total 2024 prize money offered (Hunters) \$86,700
  - Total 2024 prize money guaranteed (Hunters) \$75,000
  - Total 2023 prize money offered (Hunters) \$89,700
  - Total 2023 prize money guaranteed (Hunters) \$75,000
  - Total 2023 prize money paid (rated Hunter Divisions) \$99,240
  - Total 2023 prize money paid (Hunters) \$101,440
- 15. Prize money checks will be mailed after the conclusion of the show to the person/company as indicated in the "prize money recipient" section of entry blank. Social Security or Federal ID number and mailing address of recipient is required before any prize money will be paid. IRS Form 1099 Misc will be issued.
- 16. Any rider, regardless of age, must wear properly fastened protective headgear, which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag, at all times when mounted.
- 17. Riders may choose to wear protective vests in lieu of or in addition to a show jacket in Jumper classes. All other attire rules will still apply.
- 18. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- 19. Jumping orders will be produced in accordance with USEF Rule HU159 and JP112
- 20. Hunter courses will consist of any combination of the following: brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, panels.
- 21. For a list of classes that require jogging for soundness, please refer to page 23.
- 22. The top three placing horses/ponies in O/F classes not required to jog for soundness will be pinned in the competition ring at the conclusion of each such class. Other class ribbons will be collected individually from a central location. Please ask the ring starters or Show Secretaries for ribbon collection locations.
- 23. Champion & Reserve Champion and special awards will be pinned in the competition arenas.
- 24. Poling, including the use of offsets, is prohibited at all times.
- 25. There will be no schooling over fences in the competition rings at any time. There will be no lunging in the competition rings at any time. Lunging in warm up rings will be allowed at scheduled times. Check schedules at ring ingates.
- 26. Ring dimensions and footing: Parker Ring - 200' x 300', all-weather sand and synthetic
- Parker Ring 200' x 300', all-weather sand and synthetic Parker Ring Warm Up 130' x 260', all-weather sand and synthetic Hunter Ring II 160' x 230', all-weather sand and synthetic Hunter Ring II Warm Up 195' x 230', all-weather sand and synthetic Grand Prix Ring 310' x 240', all-weather sand and synthetic Jumper Ring II 220' x 180', all-weather sand and synthetic

  - Grand Prix Ring & Jumper Ring II Warm Up 300' x 220', all-weather sand and synthetic
  - FEI Warm Up 220' x 180', all-weather sand and synthetic
- 27. Dogs must be kept on leashes or confined at all times. A \$100 fine will be imposed for damage, disruption or interference caused by your dog. Please pick up after your dog!
- Sharps Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of medical waste. 28.
- 29. Upperville Colt & Horse Show, Inc will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way injured. Each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person whomsoever by any horses exhibited; and each exhibitor shall indemnify Upperville Colt & Horse Show, Inc against all claims or demands of any kind or nature that may grow out of injury occasioned by any horse exhibited, or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of such horse. Note agreement on entry form.
- 30. Upperville Colt & Horse Show, Inc. will not be responsible for any injury, whatsoever, to any spectator.
- 31. Upperville Colt & Horse Show, Inc. reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any attendant or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
- Exhibitors are on notice that any act of discourtesy or disobedience by them, their riders, grooms or agents to the judges or officials shall disqualify 32. their entry and the owner shall forfeit all fees and charges, including any and all prize money which may have been won at this show. The horse show management / directors shall have the power to disbar the offending individual from further competition and to have that person and that person's entire exhibit removed from the grounds without being held liable for damage of any kind and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry.

33. Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions not covered by the USEF or these rules and regulations of the Upperville Colt & Horse Show. Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to management and/or directors, whose decision shall be final.

#### STALLS / STABLING

#### Email all stall/stabling correspondence to uchs.enter@gmail.com

All horse stalls must be ordered at time of entry. Stalls are limited. National stalls are 10x10 vinyl with doors on bluestone pads under tents. FEI stalls are 11x11 vinyl with doors on bluestone pads under tents in secured stabling area. National stall fee is \$350 per stall for the week. Extra FEI stall fee is \$475 per stall for the week and subject to availability. No stall will be assigned without a corresponding paid entry. In the event of scratches after the closing date, prepaid stall fees may not be refunded.

• When entering, the entered horse can have either 0 or 1 stall requested. If a National horse stall is requested, it will be paid for with the credit card on the entry blank at the time we accept the entry.

Extra stalls must be ordered on a separate Barn Account established on HorseShowsOnline at time of entry. A valid credit card for qualified extra stalls must accompany the Barn Account.

• A Barn Account can be created by going to Online Show Entry, click Enter A Show, select Upperville, and select Create a New Barn Entry. Enter all of your extra stalls on this account using the formula below to calculate the correct maximum number of extra stalls allowed.

#### Tack/grooming stalls will be available by request as follows:

- Trainers/Entries with fewer than 3 National showing horses may NOT order such stalls. Extra stalls may be requested and will be charged and assigned if available
- Trainers/Entries with a minimum of 3 National showing horses may order up to 2 such stalls
- For Trainers/Entries with more than 3 National showing horses, additional tack/grooming stalls will then be available on a 1:3 basis 1 tack/grooming stall per 3 additional showing horses
- Additional extra stalls may be requested, and will be charged and assigned if available

The stalls on the Barn Account will not be billed until checkout, and can be split. Stall splits must be submitted at the office at check-in. If splits are not submitted at check-in, all stalls will remain on the Barn Account and must be paid at checkout in full, without splits.

#### STABLING FORM HOW-TO

Trainers who select a stall for an entered horse must fill out a Stabling Form, found on the website under the Exhibitors tab.

- Please designate your preference on the Stabling Form as to Hunter Side, Jumper Side, National stall or FEI stall.
- When completing the stabling form, please list all horses that should be stabled together.
- When completing the tack, feed, storage, and grooming stall field, please enter the total number of tack, feed, storage, and grooming stalls for the group that will be stabled together. The horses listed on your Stabling Form must match the horses entered, and the total number of extra stalls should match the requests on the Barn Accounts associated with the entries listed on the Stabling Form.
- If you would like to request additional extra stalls (over the amount allowed and subject to availability) please enter that amount in the designated field. If extra stalls are available we will contact you prior to arrival.
- Stabling will be available on Stall Master by May 29, 2024, www.stallinfo.net.

#### NOTICE:

- The stalls are leased to Upperville Colt & Horse Show and absolutely no subletting or re-selling of stalls is permitted by anyone other than Upperville Colt & Horse Show management.
- Exhibitors will be held financially responsible for damage done to the stabling tents or stalls, including punctures or permanent alterations. Damage fees charged by the tent company to the show will be added to the credit card/s on file, along with a 5% credit card processing fee. The trainer will be noted, as applicable.

#### HORSES MAY NOT BE BROUGHT ON THE GROUNDS BEFORE NOON SATURDAY, JUNE 1, 2024

#### Setups can begin on Friday, May 31, 2024

To alleviate congestion – absolutely no commercial shippers allowed on Hunter side between hours of 8 am and 4 pm on Saturday, June 8, 2024. Horse show management requests private shipping between these hours be limited.

#### PARKING

LAYOVER VANS & TRAILERS: Free parking in a designated area on the Salem Jumper Side. No vans or trailers will be allowed to park in the stable area on hunter or jumper side. Vans or trailers improperly parked will be towed at owner's expense.

SHIP-INS / DAY PARKING: Ship-ins permitted - \$60 Grounds Fee per horse except as noted\*. See parking attendant at entrance gate for directions and assistance in parking. \*No grounds fee for horses or ponies showing in the Polo Field, or ponies showing only in Lead Line or Walk-Trot.

Please read the following carefully so we can all work together to make Upperville safe and successful.

**The ONLY entrance for exhibitors and vendors to the Salem (Jumper Side) showgrounds will be off of WILLISVILLE ROAD.** Willisville Rd intersects with John S Mosby Highway (US 50) on the east end of the show grounds.

Before entering the showgrounds, a USEF Waiver must be signed by every participating adult, and every participating minor must have a Waiver signed by a parent or guardian. We ask that each participant sign their waiver digitally in advance using the HorseShowsOnline service. You will be asked to verify that your waiver has been signed at the office when you check in.

#### SHOW OFFICE PROCEDURES

To prevent crowding or excessive wait times at the office, we encourage show office business be done online whenever possible. Online add/scratch will be available from 10 am to 4 pm each day of the horse show.

All check-in and check-out must be done at the main show office next to the grandstand. A show secretary will be available at the mobile office on the Jumper side from 8 am - 4 pm daily for in-person add/scratch and jumper declarations. Please wait outside when the office staff are waiting on other people.

#### Please leave yourself plenty of time if you need to visit the office in person.

All memberships with USEF, USHJA, amateur status, horse recordings and microchips should be current. **PLEASE** double-check your status prior to entering and arrival. If any are out of date, we ask that you renew online to reduce time spent in the office.

#### HEALTH AND SAFETY FOR HORSES AND RIDERS

Management reserves the right to limit the number of horses and people in the warm up rings. Rule of thumb is 5 horses at a time per competition ring warm up area, maximum.

Please use the beautiful, designated hacking fields on the Hunter and Jumper sides for hacking, exercising or additional lunging space.

As per USEF rules, no cell phone/electronic device use is allowed while mounted or lunging.

#### **Use of Safety Protocols**

The Upperville Colt & Horse Show will have both medical and veterinary personnel available throughout the show to protect the safety of the people and horses on the showgrounds. The show managers and others will support and work with the medical and veterinary personnel as set forth in the show's written Safety Protocols to minimize risk and to facilitate the best possible medical response in case of an injury or other medical emergency involving a rider or any other person on the showgrounds, or a veterinary emergency involving a horse.

The Safety Protocol's overarching objective is to reduce the negative impact of injuries by

- (1) decreasing the time from injury on the showgrounds to the provision of definitive care at an appropriate medical or veterinary facility and
- (2) optimizing the quality of care that is provided on site.

#### **Medical and Veterinary Personnel:**

The medical personnel will consist of four qualified medical personnel as defined by USEF regulations. Two will be stationed on the Grafton Farm ("Hunter") and two on the Salem Farm ("Jumper") showgrounds during each day of competition, as determined by the Safety Coordinator.

The veterinary personnel will consist of an on-site veterinarian and staffed equine ambulance during showing hours. After-hours emergency veterinary service numbers will be posted at the show offices and published in the Prize List.



Must be entered in Classic prior to the start of their division. First round score will be from last class in respective sections. Top 12 scoring horses return for second round. Placings based on a total score from both rounds. Recognized by both NAL and WIHS.

**USHJA Green Hunter Incentive Stake** - To be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Horses participating in these classes must be enrolled in the USHJA Green Hunter Incentive Program. May be ridden by a professional, junior or amateur, and there is no limit to the number of horses a rider may compete in the class. These stakes classes will be held concurrently with the last over fences class of their respective height sections. **MUST ENTER STAKES SEPARATELY** from the Green Hunter Division classes.

**Markel Amateur Owner Hunter Classic** - Open to amateurs who showed in the regular Amateur Owner division. Judged on performance, manners, way of going. To be shown in formal attire. Must be entered in Classic prior to the start of their divisions. First round score will be from last class in respective sections. Top 12 scoring horses return for second round. Placings based on a total score from both rounds.

**Robert Pillion Memorial Pony Classics -** To be judged on performance, soundness, suitability, and manners. To be shown in formal attire. Must be entered in Classic prior to the start of their division. First round score will be from last class in respective sections. Top 12 scoring ponies return for second round.

**NAL/WIHS Adult Amateur Hunter Classic** - Open to adults who showed in the regular Adult Amateur division. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. To be shown in formal attire. Must be entered in Classic prior to the start of their division. First round score will be from last class in respective sections. Top 12 scoring horses return for second round. Placings based on a total score from both rounds. Recognized by both NAL and WIHS.

**The Paul & Eve Go As You Please Handy Hunter** - Judged on performance, manners, way of going and handiness displayed by their choice of fences. To be judged as a Handy Hunter class. Riders to choose their own line. Fence Heights will be: 3'3", 3'6" and 3'9". There will be several elements particular to Handy classes that must be included in the course. Additional elements such as trot jumps will be available for riders to incorporate into their course. Riders are required to jump a minimum of 8 obstacles / maximum of 12 obstacles and demonstrate a hand gallop. Horse and rider can only jump each obstacle one time, unless the obstacle is set to jump in both directions, then it can be jumped one time in each direction.

USHJA International Hunter Derby - Riders may not compete on more than 3 horses. All horses must be entered/declared by 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday. All horses must be on the ground by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday and must remain on the grounds until the horse is finished competing in the Derby class. Two Round Classic: Fence heights 3'6" to 4' with a maximum of 50% of the jumps set at 3'6" and a minimum of four 4' to 4'3" fences in each round set as option jumps. Tradition will be emphasized in the attire of both the riders and the horses. Horses will show in traditional hunter tack including snaffles, pelhams, double bridles and both running and standing martingales. Formal/dress attire. Round 1 Hunter Classic Course: Judged on style and brilliance. Minimum of 10 fences with at least 1 in and out, 1 bending line, and 1 line with an unrelated distance. There will be 4' to 4'3" fences set as option jumps. Obstacles will simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and a variety of derby jumps will be used. Round 2 Handy Hunter Course: A minimum of 8 obstacles will be offered in the Handy Hunter Round. Fence height 3'6" to 4', with a maximum of 50% of the jumps set at 3'6". There will be 4' to 4'3" fences in the course, set as option jumps. The course will simulate riding over trappy hunt country and will have a minimum of 3 handy options, such as: tight turn options, different track options, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle, walk over an obstacle not to exceed 18" in height, lead over an obstacle, halt and/ or back, open gate while mounted. A minimum of (12) entries, including horses tied for 12th place, must return for Round Two. Obstacles will simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course must offer a variety of derby jumps with different appearances. Judging & Ties: At least two teams of judges with at least two judges per team will officiate. Prior to the start of the class, one panel of judges will be designated as the tie breaking panel for each of the two rounds and the overall placing.

**Upperville Junior Hunter Classic -** Open to juniors who showed in the regular Junior Hunter divisions. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. To be shown in formal attire. Must be entered in Classic prior to the start of their division. First round score will be from last class in respective sections. Top 12 scoring horses return for second round. Placings based on a total score from both rounds.

**Upperville Thoroughbred Hunter Classic** - Open to horses registered as thoroughbreds and competing in the TAKE 2 Thoroughbred Hunter Division.



- WVBC Back from the Track Hack Open only to Thoroughbreds which have raced. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on suitability to become a pleasant ride. Soundness and manners to count.
- WVBC Too Slow to Go Open only to Thoroughbreds which have not raced. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on suitability to become a pleasant ride. Soundness and manners to count.

The Virginia Equine Alliance Thoroughbred Development Class - Open to Thoroughbreds only and shown under Jockey Club name. If Jockey Club papers are not available, must be able to list Thoroughbred sire and dam.

VEA Thoroughbred Development Class - To be shown over a course of eight fences with horses jumping their respective heights (2'9" thru 4'). At least 12 shall be called back to work under saddle both ways of the ring. Horses shall then be lined up and judged on conformation. Horses need not strip and any racing "adornments" will be overlooked except in relation to soundness. Over fences to count 60%, under saddle 25%, conformation 15%.

**The Founder's Cup Class** - Entries restricted to Virginia owned horses. Fence height 3', 3'3" and 3'6". Eight fences. Conformation, 25%; performance, 75%.

**Family Class** - "Family" defined for all horse show purposes as spouse, parent, step-child, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather, and in-laws of the same relationship. In all cases the word "family" is to be used rather than a list of specific relations. Horses and/or ponies to be shown under saddle at a walk and trot. Manners and suitability of mounts to riders especially considered.

**Upperville Hunter Hack** - Open to all riders and horses. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. At least eight horses, if available, are required to jump two obstacles with fence height 2'9", gallop in hand one direction of the ring.

#### TB INCENTIVE HIGH POINT PRIZE MONEY AWARDS Eligible horses must be registered as Thoroughbreds with USEF.

Prize money will be awarded to the top 3 high scoring Thoroughbreds in the following Hunter Divisions: Green Hunter 3' or 3'3", Amateur Owner Hunter 3'3" (18-35) or (36-over), Junior Hunter 3'3" (15 and under) or (16-17). Horses must be entered in respective divisions and complete at least two jumping courses to be considered for an award. Scores will be calculated by averaging the scores of each eligible entry from the 3 over fences classes in their respective sections. The 3 highest average scores from Green Hunter, Amateur Owner Hunter, and Junior Hunter will receive prize awards \$250, \$175 and \$75 respectively. In the case of a tie, the awards will be combined for tied positions and split equally.

Prize money will be awarded to the top 3 high scoring Thoroughbreds in the following Jumper Sections: 1.10 Schooling Jumper and 1.15 Schooling Jumper. Horses must be entered in and complete at least two jumping courses in their respective sections to be considered for an award. Scores will be calculated by awarding the class winner a score equal to the number of entries +1, and subtracting one point for each place in descending order. Eliminations receive 0 points. The 3 highest combined scores in each Section will receive prize awards \$250, \$175 and \$75 respectively. In the case of a tie, the award will be combined for tied positions and split equally.

## JUMPER DIVISIONS (USEF Jumper Rating 6)

All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with jumper classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-11) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. The Federation maintains records of winnings in classes at licensed competitions. Jumpers must be recorded with the Federation in order to receive points towards any USEF or USHJA Zone or Horse of the Year awards. Any change of a recorded horse's name and/or ownership must be recorded with Federation in accordance with GR1105 and GR1107.

As of Dec. 1, 2017 the USEF will require a microchip for horses and ponies competing in classes that require a USHJA horse registration. JP100.3.X (HU101/JP100/EQ103)

To be eligible for any Jumper Class, horses must be nominated except where noted. The nominating fee of \$225 must be paid by the closing date of entries. Once a horse is nominated, it becomes entitled to compete in all jumper sections. The nomination fee need only be paid once. For those classes with no nomination fee, entries should be made before closing date.

Horses must declare for the competition of their choice by 4:00 p.m. the day before the class is to be held unless otherwise noted. No poling and/or offsets will be allowed at any time on the show grounds.

The Time Allowed will be based on a speed of 382 yards per minute. The time allowed may be adjusted accordingly. In the event of a tie, there will be a jump off for first place only. All other ties will be broken by the time and faults in the first round unless otherwise noted.

Entries in the Five, Six and Seven Year Old Jumper Divisions must be age verified by USEF.


